




## **INTRODUCTION**


# **MOUs and Collaborations**

### INFRASTRUCTURE AUGMENTATION

Yeldo Mar Baselios College has been functioning at Puthuppady with three distinctive blocks in the campus Administrative Block, Marian Block and Media and Design Block

The Principal's Office and the Main Administrative Office are located in this block. There is an Air conditioned Miniplex Theatre named as 'Tagore Theatre' with 142 seats functioning in this block. 


